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EU common values have a central role for the project of Technical Assistance for Students Learning about the EU Common Values, Fundamental Rights and Policies. In relation to the project's aim, international conference focuses on what kind of a tool education can be in raising awareness of Turkish society about EU common values as one of activities of the project.

### The Background of the Conference Theme

Education systems in Europe are rooted in national traditions and are characterized by specific national elements. It is not possible to speak about a single European education system. Forty-four education systems are included covering 36 countries participating in the EU's Erasmus+ Programme (EU Member States, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Montenegro, the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Norway, Serbia and Turkey). Interesting point here is however, in which way the systems respond to common goals which are set by the European Union. "Unity in Diversity" is of particular importance in implementing policies: we must know the differences and their roots before more unity can be made.

Since 2000, conscious of the importance of Education and Training for their economic and social objectives, EU Member States have begun working together to achieve specific goals in the field of education. By sharing examples of good policy practice, by taking part in Peer Learning activities, by setting benchmarks and by tracking progress against key indicators, the 28 Member States aim to respond coherently to common challenges, whilst retaining their individual sovereignty in the field of education policy. This strategy is referred to as the Education and Training 2020 programme (ET2020), which is an update of the Education and Training 2010 programme.

At the Conference of "Turkey and EU Common Values: Reflections on the Education System" answers for questions about education will be sought by taking into consideration conditions of the era we are in.

Arzu Akar has undergraduate degrees from both Department of Economics and Department of Politics and International Relations in Bahçeşehir University. Following her graduation, she started her graduate degree at Institute of European Union in Marmara University on European Economy. Afterwards, she completed her graduate degree at London School of Economics in England on European Social Policy.

Since her university years, she has done voluntary works at CSOs. After a short period of private sector experience, she continued her professional life as a project expert at CSOs that were active in youth, women, and development issues. She worked as a research assistant at Graduate School of Social Sciences in Dokuz Eylül University. ## Prof. Dr. Sanem Baykal

The Director of Ankara University

Sanem Baykal is a Professor of European Union Law at Ankara University Law Faculty. She obtained her LLB from Ankara University Law Faculty, her LLM from the University of London in European Law as a Jean Monnet Scholar and her PhD from Ankara University in European Union Law. During 2004–2005 she was an Emile Noël Fellow and a Hauser Research Scholar at New York University School of Law. She has worked at the Turkish Ministry for EU Affairs as the Director of EU Law Directorate between October 2009 and October 2012. She is currently the Head of the EU Law Department at Ankara University Law Faculty, as well as the Head of the Graduate Studies in European Union at Ankara University at the Department of European Union and International Economic Relations. She is also the Director of Ankara University European Research Centre since September 2015. Dr. Baykal has published monographs, book chapters and articles on EU Law and Turkey–EU relations.





## Sergij Gabrscek

Dr. Sergij Gabrscek has over 35 years' experience as Researcher, Consultant, Key Expert and Team Leader in all levels of education. He started his professional career as a researcher at the university research institute Jozef Stefan in Ljubljana, Slovenia. He established the National Examination Centre in Slovenia and was its Director General in the period 1992-1999, introducing the first external secondary school leaving examinations in Slovenia that replaced all entrance examinations for higher education institutions. Slovenia has served as an example for nearly all assessment activities in countries that have developed and introduced external assessment after 1995 in countries of Central and Eastern Europe, South-East Europe and many NIS countries.

Dr. Gabrscek has been involved in many projects in and outside the region in different countries (Lithuania, Moldova, Ukraine, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia, Croatia, Macedonia, Nigeria, South Sudan and many others) working with national and international organisations. The focus of his professional work moved to the interface between education and labour market and employment. He has been working with all levels of education (primary education, general secondary education, VET and higher education) in the areas of curriculum development, assessment and examinations, teacher' professional development, quality assurance, monitoring and evaluation non-formal and informal leaning and national qualifications frameworks. In some countries in Europe, Africa and The Middle East he was involved in the development of teachers' professional competences and their capacity building.

He was working with the key International Institutions such as the European Union, World Bank, Open Society Institute, DFID in many countries.

He attended post-graduate courses at the University of Cambridge and University of Chicago and in the academic year 2002/2003 he was a Fulbright Scholar at the University of California at Berkeley. He also received the National Award for Research and Development work in Slovenia in 1992

His bibliography shows a number of research papers, papers on different conferences, for many of which he was an invited speaker. It also shows publications in renowned journals and monographies. His work is marked not only by professionalism, but also by enthusiasm, creativity and humour.
